Duties: The research comprises studies of atypical pestivirus infections among production animals and among wild animals.

Qualifications: A prerequisite for this position is a PhD degree, or a foreign degree deemed to be equivalent to a doctorate, in a relevant subject area. Experiences in molecular biological techniques, cell culturing and techniques for virus and antibody detection are desired. Knowledge and experience in project leading and research communication are meriting. The PhD degree should have been awarded no longer than three years before the final application date, unless there are mitigating circumstances.
